GRANTS.GOV* Release Notes Overview

- Grants.gov Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)
 - Grants.gov enforced Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) through Login.gov, PIV/CAC, or AMS
 - Removed simple, single-factor, authentication mechanism
 - Moved "Forgot My Username/Forgot My Password" links to Link to Grants.gov Account page
 - Updated Grants.gov registration process to help users link their accounts to an MFA option
- User Impacts
 - Applicant Login to Grants.gov
 - No impact to EBiz POC Login
 - No impact on System-to-System
 - No impact to Mobile and third-party login (continue to use **Grants.gov account credentials)**

MFA ENHANCEMENTS



GRANTS.GOV* Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)

- Username and Password fields have been removed from the Grants.gov Login page.
- Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) is now enforced to increase security and to comply with Federal security requirements. This is done by removing single-factor authentication functionality and by enforcing the use of MFA for all users accessing the Grants.gov application.






GRANTS.GOV" Login.gov Login Landing Page

- Users will need to create a Login.gov account during the linking process if they don't already have one.






GRANTS.GOV* Forgot Username/Forgot Password

users linking their Grants.gov account with Login.gov.






Registration Page

- Under the "Registration" page, new text has been added to the "Grants.gov Account Details" section to clarify that the user is entering a Grants.gov username and password.


