







1. Draw an oval




2. Draw a slightly curved line




3. Draw 2 lines to form the tail, they should come to a point on the right and attach to the oval on the left




4. Draw another oval, shaped like an egg with the narrow end down. Leave some space between this oval and the big one - it's part of the head.




5. Connect the ovals with 2 curved lines to create the neck




6. Draw a sideways V, make the lines curve up a little bit.




7. Finish the face with 3 more lines, they attach to the V you drew for the mouth and the oval shape of the head.




8. Draw the thigh with 2 lines that start inside the big oval and end on the bottom of the oval.



9. The calves (lower legs) look like 2 U shapes. Draw #1 under the middle of the oval. Draw #2 under the base of the tail, then connect it to the thigh lines.



10. The feet
are 2
rectangles.




11. Now draw the toes. Tyrannosaurus rex had 3 large clawed toes, and a small claw on the back of their feet.

Since the right foot is turned, only draw 2 toes, you can't see the third.


The toes are shaped like bananas, with a claw at the end that curves down.

The middle toe is longer than the side toes




12. The arms are drawn with 2 parallel curved lines. The hands have two claws. Draw a sideways W, and connect the W to the arm.

Do the same for the other arm.



13. Erase your guidelines:
look closely at the previous
step and erase the lines you
don't see here.

Now you have the outline
of your T. rex!



14. Add details:
the eye, nostril,
teeth, ear,
and skin folds.

You now have your
own drawing of SUE!
