- Implementing new features and investigating/fixing bugs

- Offering support to QA engineers during the testing phase
- Releasing features on the production Kubernetes cluster and monitoring releases soon afterward.
- Reporting and resolving technical debt issues like the upgrade of libraries and frameworks and working on bringing older services to a better technical & test coverage level
