As a small organization, we enjoy the luxury of pressing hard on the gas and turning on a dime. We're known as being one of the first to release new Unicode emoji yearly.


As an enterprise level product, we must always maintain a high level of service. More than that, we simply believe in treating others with prompt attention and kindness.









WECTOR BASED EMOJI ICONS







Our emoji keyboard for Chrome browser



Dropbox Paper






Screenshots from Telegram Desktop for Mac.








Usage included both out of home materials, retail posters, and digital ads. Ads that contain emoji have proven to grab more attention than those without.








