As a communications intern at The Danish House in Palestine (DHIP), you will become part of a small but dedicated team based in Ramallah, Occupied West Bank. Our work focuses on empowering Palestinian children and youth through arts, culture, and education, and we need your help to share their stories.

We are looking for an intern who can help support our digital communication and engage a wider audience in Denmark. Through social media, newsletters, campaigns, and events, you will play a key role in amplifying DHIP's work and the voices of the children and youth we support.

If you are looking for a meaningful internship that will challenge you, develop your communication skills, and give you unique insights into life in Palestine, we encourage you to apply.

About the internship

Every day, we work with stories that deserve to be told. As a communications intern at DHIP, you will be a key part of our efforts to share narratives about arts, culture, and resilience in Palestine.

You will work closely with our Communications Manager and have the opportunity to develop and execute creative communication strategies that reach a broad audience in Denmark.

This is an exciting and hands-on internship where you will gain practical experience in communication within an international NGO while experiencing Palestine firsthand.

Your tasks will include

- Producing photo, video, and audio content from DHIP's activities, depending on your skills and interests
- Joining field visits with partners to document activities
- Planning and producing content for social media, newsletters, and website
- Developing visual and written campaigns that engage our Danish audience
- Organizing small events such as film screenings and talks
- Contributing to fundraising, awareness and advocacy campaigns

In short, you will play a central role in ensuring that DHIP's work is seen and heard.

About you

You have experience in digital communication and understand how to create engaging content. You write fluently in both Danish and English, work independently, and take responsibility for your tasks. You are curious about Palestine and value listening and telling complex stories with nuance.

Experience with social media, journalism, or visual communication is an advantage. Arabic language skills are also beneficial but not required. Most important is your motivation.

The internship is unpaid. The internship period is subject to agreement, but we prefer a stay of at least 3 months. Working hours are 30-35 hours per week, with flexible arrangements. The position is based at The Danish House in Palestine, Ramallah, West Bank.
