Our Why

IEP goals are the heart of the educational program for students with disabilities.

We believe that we can improve our system design so that **100%** of IEP goals can be achieved, setting students up for a lifetime of access and success.

Quarter 1 Improvement Data

- 81% of families engaged in pre-IEP meeting collaboration.
- **66%** of students participated in the development of their IEP.
 - **46% improvement** from one year ago
- **63%** of IEPs utilized the attendance script.
 - **30% improvement** from last year
- 54% of case managers utilized the decision tree when drafting services.
- 100% of goals with a documented response.

67% of IEP goals marked met! 26% Improvement
Baseline approx 41%

Current Work and Next Steps

We implemented and ***achieved improvement*** using

- IEP Review process
- Goal quality rubric
- Parent collaboration questionnaire

Next step: Collect data on this process quarterly. (Beginning of November)

We implemented but are ***working on sustained improvement with***

- Student IEP participation
- IEP attendance script
