

## Archival Work and Projects in 2025

Haiti's History of Revolution and Resistance [timeline](#) uses archival documents and audio recordings uniquely available in the Freedom Archives to explore Haiti's vibrant history of resistance, and especially the significance and legacy of the Haitian Revolution resulting in the creation of the first independent Black republic. Our [project page](#) includes additional resources to learn more and support Haiti.

In commemoration of the [50th Anniversary of the Viet Nam Victory](#) against US Imperialism, the Freedom Archives digitized 12 items which highlight the strength of solidarity with Viet Nam among forces here in the Bay Area and beyond.

Our [Anti-Nuclear Activism collection](#) contains materials from Anti-nuclear Student Organizing, primarily related to the work of Berkeley Students for Peace and the University of California Nuclear Weapons Labs Conversion Project. Major topics include student and faculty organizing efforts to sever ties with, or convert, the UC weapons labs; the community-led 1976 walk for disarmament; community organizing against uranium mining; and more. Additional contents include issues of Anti-Nuclear periodicals and partial runs of No Nuclear News and Groundswell.




Pamphlet Cover from material in Anti-Nuclear Activism collection

# Watching the Seeds of Creativity Bloom




