

Notice to Exhibitors

The Show Building will be available on Thursday when ready, but not before 3:00 P.M., until 10:00 P.M. for unloading.

The Show Building will be open 6:30 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. Friday through Saturday and 6:30 A.M. until one half hour after completion of judging on Sunday, after which time all dogs must be removed from the building.

Exhibitor Day Parking \$5.00 Per Day.

Indoor Grooming - Electricity rates are \$40.00 for three days and \$15.00 for single days.

Crated dogs will be allowed to remain in the Cow Palace overnight, through Saturday night, PROVIDED that each crate is identified with the name and address of the responsible party. A local phone number for contacting the responsible party must be provided for all dogs left overnight. The clubs are not responsible for dogs left in the building.

No Soft Crates allowed except in the Obedience Crating Area.

RV (Recreational Vehicles) Parking Information:

- The show site will be available for RV parking at 12:00 Noon on Thursday, April 16, 2026.
- Pre-reserved RV parking space - \$50.00 per night.
- RV parking space after deadline or on site with no reservation - additional \$10.00 per night.
- Electric is never guaranteed! It is strongly suggested to arrive with the ability to be self contained if necessary (including but not limited to a site power outage, etc.)

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.





3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
