The Show Building will be available on Thursday when ready, but not before 3:00 P.M.

The Show Building will be open at 6:30 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. Friday through Saturday and 6:30 A.M. until one half hour after completion of judging on Sunday, after which time all dogs must be removed from the buildings.

Exhibitor Day Parking \$5.00 Per Day.

Indoor Grooming - Electricity rates are \$40.00 for three days and \$15.00 for single days.

Crated dogs will be allowed to remain in the Cow Palace overnight, through Saturday night, PROVIDED that each crate is identified with the name and address of the responsible party. A local phone number for contacting the responsible party must be provided for all dogs left overnight. The club is not responsible for dogs left in the building. There will be no watchman in the building overnight.

No Floor Tape to be used in the building.

No Soft Crates allowed.

The Columbia Terrier Association of Maryland, Inc. will hold, as part of the regular judging after the selection of Best of Breed/Variety, competition for Best Puppy to be selected from the four (4) puppy class winners (6-9 dogs, 9-12 dogs, 6-9 bitches and 9-12 bitches). This selection will be made by the regular class judge and the winner of Best Puppy in each breed will then compete in the Puppy Group to be judged just prior to Best in Group. To be eligible for Best Puppy, a dog must be entered in and placed first in one of the four regular puppy classes. The 12-18 Month class is not a puppy class. Should a puppy be awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that puppy would automatically be Best Puppy for that breed/variety. If the winner of a puppy class is not present for Best Puppy judging, a second place puppy may not compete in its place.




