PRE-SESSIONAL ENGLISH COURSES

Pre-Sessional English Courses for Undergraduate & Postgraduate Applicants.

If you're applying to study with us but don't think you will meet your chosen course's minimum English Language requirements, you might qualify for one of our Pre sessional English courses.

Courses of 6-16 weeks are online and includes live video- based, interactive sessions with our English for Academic Purposes lecturers and your classmates.

You can choose from the following course durations and fees:

- 16 weeks – £3,900

- 6 weeks – £1,817

Entry & Exit Levels
