FORTNITE TOURNAMENT

DUOS DROP IN

DAY 1: FRIDAY – THE QUALIFIERS

- * **Format:** Duo Round Robin Drop In
- * **How it Works:** All registered duos will play 2-3 qualifying matches
- * **Goal:** Your goal is to score as many points as possible. Points are awarded based on a combination of match placement and total kills.
- * **Advancement:** There is no limit on how many teams can compete on Friday, but only the Top 8 duos with the highest cumulative point totals at the end of the day will advance to the finals.

DAY 2: SATURDAY – TOURNAMENT FINALS

IMPORTANT: Only the Top 8 teams face off in a high-stakes bracket.

- * **Format:** Duo Kill Race
- * **Bracket:** Single Elimination. Win and advance; lose and you're out.
- * **How it Works:** The 8 qualifying teams will be placed into a bracket. Each match will consist of one duo competing against another duo in the same lobby. (2 duos in a Quads match)
- * **Winning a Match:** This day is all about pure slaying power. The team with the highest number of combined kills at the end of the match wins and moves on to the next round.

Point System:Kill Points - Each Kill: 1 Point

Placement Points - Placement points are awarded based on the team's final rank in the match.

Victory Royale (1st): 15 Points
2nd: 12 Points
3rd: 10 Points
4th: 8 Points
5th: 7 Points
6th - 10th: 5 Points
11th - 15th: 3 Points
16th - 25th: 1 Point

CLASH ROYALE TOURNAMENT SINGLE ELIMINATION

DAY 1: FRIDAY – THE QUALIFIERS

- * Format: In-App Mega Draft Challenge
- * How it Works: All registered players will be given the Name and Password for a private, in-game tournament.
- * This tournament will be set to the Mega Draft game mode.
- * The tournament will be open for a specific time window
- * Goal: Your goal is to battle opponents and climb the in-game tournament leaderboard. Your rank is determined by your performance (wins/losses).
- * Advancement: At the end of the time limit, the Top 16 players on the final leaderboard will qualify for Saturday's Championship Bracket.

DAY 2: SATURDAY – CHAMPIONSHIP BRACKET

IMPORTANT: Only the Top 16 finalists battle for the crown in a head-to-head bracket.* Format: 1v1 Single Elimination

- * How it Works: The 16 qualifying players will be seeded into a single-elimination bracket based on their rank from Day 1.
- * Winning a Match: Each match in the bracket will be a Best-of-1 series. The Championship round will be a Best of 3 series

Players are allowed to switch decks between games.

- * How to Play: Designated phones and tablets will be used to complete the 1v1 tournament. Players will be given 3 minutes prior to round to set up a personal deck. Matches will start promptly after 3 minutes.
